Her brother, Tony, promised his sister that he would shave his head with her and remain bald until her hair grew back. Tony, a teacher at Lake Shore High School in Buffalo, brought this idea to his students and many offered to help. One student suggested that they raise money and then do the shaving together. And a fundraiser was born! In the years since the program was founded, thousands of participants across Western New York have joined forces to raise over \$5 million to help find cures and save lives.
